International Maritime Organisation (IMO) Recognised Model Training Courses

The course we operate are as follows:

- IMO Level 1 - Beachmaster Course
- IMO Level 2 - Incident Controller Endorsement Course

IMO Level 1 - Beachmaster Course

Course Duration:	3 days
Pre-Qualifications:	Previous Oil Spill Knowledge or MCA level 2 is required for this course
Suitable Attendees:	Personnel who are seeking a more complex understanding of oil spill response.
Brief Description:	This course will provide a more in depth and technical outlook through practical and theoretical explanations of oil spill clean up.

IMO Level 2 - Supervisor on Scene Commander Course

Course Duration:	5 days
Pre-Qualifications:	Previous Oil Spill Knowledge or MCA level 2/3 / IMO level 1 is required for this course
Suitable Attendees:	Personnel who would be in overall control of an area where an oil pollution incident has taken place.
Brief Description:	To provide a good level of technical knowledge required to assess situations, design strategies and manage teams of cleanup personnel.
