Course Description: This course has been developed from the FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency)

This course is intended for individuals who may assume a supervisory role in expanding incidents or Type 3 incidents. Prerequisites for the course are the ICS- 100 and ICS-200 courses. This course covers organization and staffing, organizing for incidents and events, resource management, and air operations.
